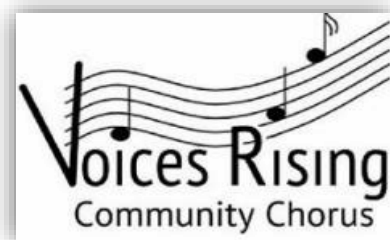
Sunday, September 16th at 3:00 pm
